1.Co-option of a Councillor to fill one of the casual vacancies

James Nutman was unanimously co-opted.

2.Apologies for absence. There were none.

3. To receive members Declarations of Interest on agenda items.

4. Public comment In the Stowmarket Area Action Plan Onehouse was classed as a secondary village and not eligible for large development. In the new Joint Local Plan Onehouse is classed as hinterland and has already absorbed over the percentage of housing required with the Hopkins development.

5. To agree and approve the content of the consultation document to residents regarding a possible judicial review of MSDC decision to grant planning permission for application 20/01110 Outline Planning Application. (Access to be considered) for the erection of up to 146no dwellings including vehicular and pedestrian accesses, public open space, play space, landscaping, associated highways, drainage and utilities infrastructure. Land To The South Of Union Road Onehouse and take any necessary action.

After discussion Cllr Crissell proposed that OPC seeks the opinion of a barrister to see if we have a case for a Judicial Review on a no won no fee basis. The £2000.00 for professional assistance regarding LDF land bids reserve can be used for this. Once this information is known then residents will be consulted to find out if they wish OPC to take the matter to Judicial Review. This was seconded by Cllr Copping and carried.
